

SCHOOL SUPPLIES
KINDERGARTEN
2009-2010

On the first day of school, all children need to bring the following items to share with the class. (You may also bring the supplies to Parent Orientation Night on August 17.)

Please DO NOT label any of the following items:

- ___ 1 box of Crayola washable, Thin, Classic color markers
- ___ 1 box of Crayola washable, Thick markers - any other color (bold, bright, etc.)
- ___ 2 large pencils ("My First Pencil")
- ___ 4 large glue sticks (.7 oz. or larger size)
- ___ 1 4-pack of **Expo Vis-à-vis nontoxic** markers (any colors)
- ___ 1 rectangular box of Kleenex tissues
- ___ 1 box of quart-size Ziplock bags
- ___ 1 pair of blunt tip Fiskars scissors

Please LABEL the following with a permanent marker

- ___ 1 2-pocket folder labeled on the inside (**no center strip with prongs and no plastic folders please**)
- ___ 1 2-pocket folder with the center strip of prongs labeled on the inside (**no plastic folders please**)
- ___ 1 pair of gym shoes with Velcro or some type of fastener other than laces (to be left at school)
